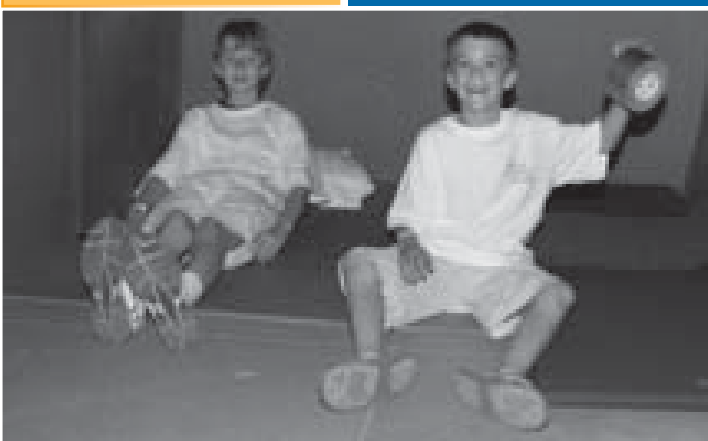

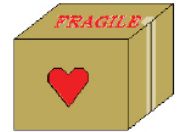

Frequently Asked Questions

What can I bring to the event? Cardboard box, sleeping bag, pad, tarp, pillow, warm clothes. You may bring medications, cell phones and essential toiletries, but please refrain from bringing outside food, or other non-essential objects. The following items are not allowed: Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, beverages in glass bottles, weapons of any kind, personal electronic devices such as MP3 players or video games.

Is it safe for me to send my children? We require a minimum of one adult chaperone for every five participants under the age of 18. Additionally, we will have volunteers serve as security staff at all hours of the event. Event will be held in a gated area.
